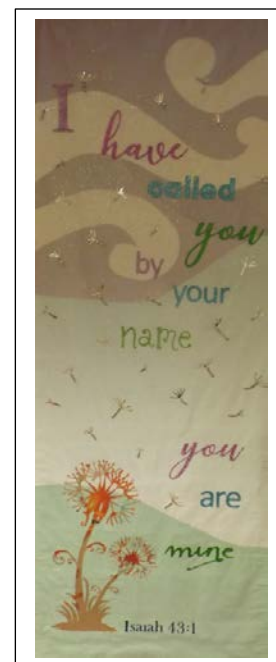

As you can see our attendance in general is excellent, our average attendance is 97.4% There are however a few pupils whose attendance is close to or indeed has dropped below 90% and we will be monitoring these pupils closely. 90% is a significant percentage as pupils who miss 10% of school are considered to be 'Persistent Absentees'. Letters will be sent out at the end of this term to the families of those children that we are monitoring.
