

Charging and Remissions Policy 2023 - 2024

No.	Income Activity	Approved Charge
1	Music Tuition	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Year 4 Wider Opportunities Music Tuition – costs to be paid by the school. This is currently supplied by ‘Love Music Trust’. Year 5 Continuation Music Tuition – paid for by parents/carers.
2	Adult Education	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Currently no adult education is done on site, but should it commence charges would be as per LA recommended “Schools Lettings Charges”.
3	Other Casual Lettings	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Pre-School charge is set at £500 per term Health professionals who assist children with special needs in school – no charge. DR Sports Holiday Club charge is set at £40 per day for room hire, opening/closing and cleaning per day. Currently no other casual lettings are done, but should they commence, they would be as per LA recommended further guidance by Cheshire East.
4	Personal Photocopying (for staff)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> 5p per black & white copy. 10p for colour copy.
5	Educational Visits	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> In compliance with the Education Act of 1996 all curriculum-based visits necessary to complete a given course are funded on a voluntary contribution basis. No child will be excluded from the activity or treated differently because they do not contribute, however if voluntary contributions are not sufficient then it may be that the planned activity or trip cannot go ahead. By giving consent for your child to attend this trip we will assume that the full amount of the voluntary contribution will be made, unless we hear from you to the contrary. The actual cost for the school trip (including educational activity cost and transport) rounded up to the nearest 10p. All parents/carers will have to pay for optional extras on residential trips including board/lodgings and all meals. <p>Remissions:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> If a child is eligible for Pupil Premium, parents need to contact Miss Groarke. Pupils who do not attract the Pupil Premium: Parents may request a discount on the price of the trip. The amount will be determined on a case-by-case basis after discussion with the Head Teacher. The funds for this will be drawn from the school budget. Financial assistance for transport costs may be given by the PTA for specific visits.
6	Swimming Lessons	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> No cost for a swimming lesson will be levied. Costs for transport and any extra swimming instructors will be charged to parents – rounded up to the nearest 10p (via ParentPay)
7	Educational Resources	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> If the resource is used to raise standards the cost must be the responsibility of the school. If it is an optional or enrichment item, the cost can be passed onto the parents/carers. Financial assistance for educational resources may be given by the PTA for specific items.
8	Afterschool Activities	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Afterschool clubs/activities provided by teachers will be charged at a nominal fee, per club, depending on resources needed (via ParentPay). Afterschool activities provided by external companies are charged according to providers’ provisions and terms. <p>Remissions:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Pupil Premium Children: Parents can request financial assistance on the cost of the club.
