Thank you to all the parents who have contributed towards the Diocesan Building Fund so far. However, we are still short of our target amount of £3195. This is an extremely important fund to us as it allows us to complete many building projects. We have benefitted from this in recent years, for projects such as the new heating system and replacement of parts of the roof. The Diocese request a voluntary contribution of £15 per child per year and each school is given a target income based on the number on role. When the income from parents falls short of the target the school has to make up the difference from its own budget thus reducing money that goes directly to the children. The contribution is a small price to pay for such a fantastic school!
