

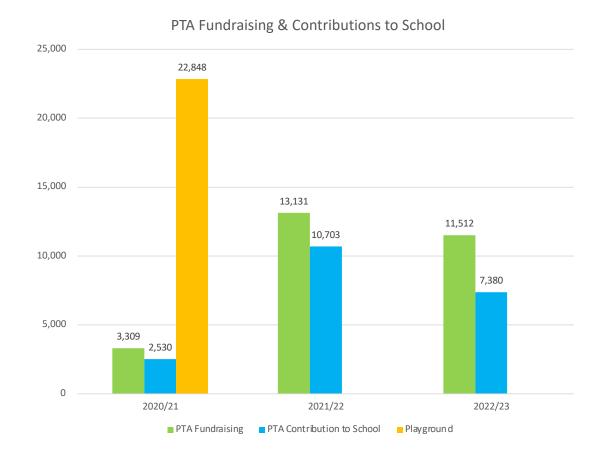

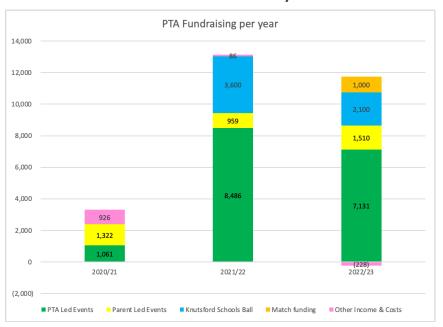
PTA Fundraising & Contributions to School (post Covid)

- The graph shows the total funds raised by the PTA & the amounts paid to school during the last 3 years
 - 2020/21 PTA events were severely affected by Covid restrictions
- During 2020/21 the PTA contributed £23k to the cost of the revamped playground. These funds were raised in the prior 2 years and therefore have been highlighted separately
- 2022/23 final contributions to school will be higher than £7.4k as the contribution to the outdoor classroom has yet to be determined

- Parent Led Events shout out to the Dads! Great fundraising effort with c£1k raised each year
- Match funding does your employer provide this? We have raised £1k from Barclays and £150 Film on the Field sponsorship from KPMG this year

School contributions – where did the money go?

- Some costs are consistent across all years e.g.
 Year 6 hoodies & leavers gifts
- Most costs are unique to each year, depending on the school's requirements
 - Various educational workshops & trips have been supported by PTA funds
 - New technology funded smart board, microphone & visualisers
 - Forest School has benefitted from new fencing, a new shed & pond improvements
 - Reading corners in each classroom were improved in 2023
- Some of the 2023 monies are yet to be paid to school & the contribution for the outdoor classroom is yet to be determined
