What do you think are the strengths of our school?

- Spiritually the school is excellent and looks after its pupils.
- The strong links children have with younger children through reading buddies is excellent.
- Parish links, great visitors and trips, stay and learn sessions are great!
- Very strong Catholic education both in lessons and all aspects of school life.
- The Catholic ethos, values and guidance provided is evident throughout the school and is reflected in the positive and supportive behaviour of the children .

- Behaviour is of a very high standard, this shows with all its pupils in and out of school. It's nurturing and looking after younger children via the older children is so heartwarming and beautiful. The connection the school have with all the families is so special and strong and we always feel like part of the family.
- St Vincent's is in our view an amazing school where we believe that each pupil matters. All of the staff are friendly and helpful and nothing is ever too much trouble.

- The teachers are very good in SEND support. We have a child starting in Reception and are very happy with the support and effort that has been made to help her in school. We were worried about them starting and struggling but feel very at ease.

What do you think St. Vincent's could do to further enhance its curriculum?

- Encourage students to try and relate more with other cultures The school provides good Catholic teachings, but we would like to see the teachings of other religions, such as Buddhism and Islam, even just a couple of lessons, to give a wider religious and cultural education. The RE curriculum is currently changing and now includes other faiths. We have a Muti Cultural week and follow Diocesan guidance for the teaching of RE.
- Variety of homework, too easy, too hard, text books or online etc. This will be reviewed again in 2024 -2025
- More could be done by the parish to connect with the St Vincent's children. They are the future of the parish and without the parish being proactive in connecting with these families, the church will not survive another generation. – This year we have planned in Class led Masses on occasional Sundays.
- I think the school does exceptionally well with enrichment activities for the children and it would be great for this to continue. I also hope that pushing the more able pupils in challenge groups continues. I think the school has such a good balance in all respects. We are so blessed to have such a lovely school. This year we continue to challenge our children and as an extra we introduced challenge groups in English and Maths in KS2.
