Homework

- **Reading books** New reading books will be sent home every Wednesday and need to be returned the following Monday. Please record in your child's reading diary every time they read. We expect reading at home to happen at least 3 times per week.
- Reading for Pleasure books Next week we will allow the children to choose a book from our mini class library to share at home. Children will be able to pick a new book every Wednesday if they return their previous book.
- Homework book We will be sending home a weekly homework book starting next week.
 These books will be sent home every Wednesday and should be returned the following
 Tuesday. We will be sending homework that consolidates learning from that week's lessons.
- **Spellings** On Wednesday, we will be sending home weekly spellings with the spelling test taking place the following Wednesday.
- Tapestry Tapestry will continue in Year 1 but take a different form. We will use it to set homework, send out information or to give you a little insight into what we are doing in school. Observations will not be as frequent as they were in Reception. However, we welcome your contributions from home to help us develop a wider understanding of each individual and to celebrate their achievements.

Things to remember

- PE kits are needed on Thursday and Friday but will remain in school until half term.
- Please ensure that your child brings a sports water bottle, with their name on, to school every day. This must only contain water.
- Please check that your child's name is clearly labelled in all of their belongings.

It has been lovely getting to know your children; they have lots of energy and enthusiasm for the year ahead. We will try our best to get to know you all as soon as possible and are starting to put names to faces at the gate.
